**Memorandum of Understanding
Girls Wrestling Coach Stipend**

This Memorandum of Understanding (“MOU”) is entered into by and between the Temecula Valley Unified School District (“District”) and the Temecula Valley Education Association (“Association”).


WHEREAS, on May 24, 2019, the District and Association executed a Memorandum of Understanding concerning stipends. The MOU called for the creation of a Girls Volleyball Junior Varsity Reserve Stipend of 4% of the Stipend/Extra Duty Base.

WHEREAS, the District’s high schools have not fielded Girls Volleyball Junior Varsity Reserve teams. Rather, all three High Schools fielded a Girls Wrestling team during the 2019-2020 school year.

NOW THEREFORE, THE PARTIES AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

1. The recitals listed above are true and correct.
2. Effective during the 2020-2021 school year, the Girls Volleyball Junior Varsity Reserve stipend shall be replaced with the Girls Wrestling Coach stipend.
3. The new Girls Wrestling Coach stipend shall take effect during the 2020-2021 school year and will be incorporated into the Collective Bargaining Agreement during the next round of negotiations.
4. This MOU is non-precedent setting and may not be cited to support any particular interpretation of the Collective Bargaining Agreement.
5. This MOU is subject to Governing Board approval.


