

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN TEMECULA VALLEY UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT
AND TEMECULA VALLEY EDUCATORS ASSOCIATION

Elementary Preparation Time and Common Intervention Time
May 14, 2024

This Memorandum of Understanding (“MOU”) is entered into by and between the Temecula Valley Unified School District (“District”) and the Temecula Valley Educators’ Association (“Association”).

WHEREAS, the Parties have a mutual interest in revising the preparation time provided in Transitional Kindergarten through and including fifth grade, as described herein.

WHEREAS, the Parties have a mutual interest in implementing a common intervention block, as described below.

NOW, THEREFORE, the District and Association agree as set forth below:

1. **Elementary Preparation Time:** The Parties agree to increase the preparation time described in Article 5.7 from 150 minutes per week to 200 minutes per week during the 2024-25 and 2025-26 school years. With the exception of this revision, the remaining terms of Article 5.7 remain unchanged. Kindergarten, for purposes of this paragraph, shall include Transitional Kindergarten.
2. **Common Intervention Time:** The Parties agree to implement a common intervention time consisting of thirty-minute common intervention blocks each regular (non-modified) bell schedule day at each grade level in first through fifth grades at each elementary school. The Parties agree to implement a common intervention time consisting of at least fifteen-minute common intervention blocks each regular (non-modified) bell schedule day at each grade level in transitional kindergarten and kindergarten at each elementary school. With the exception of these revisions, the remaining terms of Article 5.12 remain unchanged.
3. **Term:** This MOU will expire June 30, 2026. The terms of this MOU shall not constitute the status quo following June 30, 2026. The status quo shall be the terms of the collective bargaining agreement and any other currently effective memoranda of understanding.
4. **Past Practice:** This MOU does not establish a past practice and is a non-precedent setting. This MOU may not be cited to support any particular interpretation of the CBA.
